The Kingston City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, August 9, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. Councilman Don White called the meeting to order. Councilman White then asked for nominations for a Chairman to conduct the meeting. Councilman Sugarman nominated Councilman Byrkit and was seconded by Councilman White. Motion made to approve by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman White. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 5 Ayes


APPROVE KINGSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT LIST OF ITEMS FOR SURPLUS
