The Regular Meeting of the Kingston City Council was held at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 13, 2014 Vice Mayor Neal called the meeting to order. Councilman Brown gave the invocation and Councilwoman Nichols led the pledge. Upon roll call the following members were present: Councilman Brown, Councilman Byrkit, Vice Mayor Neal, Councilwoman Nichols, Councilman Sugarman and Councilman White. Mayor Beets was absent.

PREVIOUS MINUTES

A motion made by Councilman White, second by Councilwoman Nichols to waive the reading and approve as written the minutes of the regular meeting on October 14, 2014. The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 6 Ayes

A motion made by Councilman Sugarman, second by Councilman White to approve a Subornation Agreement for the home at 1112 Circle Drive. (Pamela Miles) The motion passed with a unanimous roll call vote. 6 Ayes

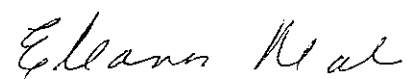
A motion made by Councilwoman Nichols, second by Councilman Byrkit to adjourn the meeting passed with a unanimous voice vote.
