



The weather was beautiful, the boats were fast as lightning, and the crowd was bathed in sunshine—the day ended in an amazing display of fireworks at dusk.

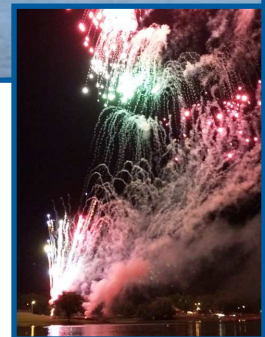
