





MINUTES KINGSTON PLANNING COMMISSION AUGUST 15, 2017

The regular meeting of the Kingston Planning Commission was held at 6:00 p.m. on August 15, 2017 at the Kingston City Hall.

CALL TO ORDER/MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman King. On a motion by Mayor Neal and a second by Mr. Botkin, the commission voted to approve the minutes of the July 18, 2017 minutes of the planning commission and the July 18, 2017 minutes of the joint city council/planning commission meeting.

STAFF REPORTS

Mayor Neal informed the planning commission that ordinance to allow PUDs in the C-4 district had passed on first reading. A public hearing and second reading will be held at the next city council meeting.

City Manager Bolling stated that there was a vacancy on the historic planning commission. In keeping with the city's policy, an advertisement regarding the vacancy will be run in the local newspaper.

SITE PLAN REVIEW - KINGSTON MEDICAL OFFICE FOR DR. BHAVNA VORA ON RACE STREET

Staff introduced the site plan for the proposed Kingston Medical Office for Dr. Bhavna Vora. The site plan showed a proposed 80' X 50' medical building to be located on the west side of Race Street. Staff stated that he had corresponded with the original project developer, Mr. Jerry Crowe regarding the site plan. Mr. Crowe had made requested changes to the site plan including showing the locations of existing utilities. Staff stated that he had informed Mr. Crowe that there was no required number of parking spaces so parking could be reduced, if desired. Dr. Vora stated that she preferred the parking, as shown.

Staff Comments and Recommendations
Staff recommended that the site plan be approved.

Chairman King noted that the driveway did not appear to be 90 degrees. The commission then questioned whether a driveway permit had been issued by TDOT. City Manager Bolling stated that he had not been notified that a permit had been issued. Staff and Dr. Vora were also unsure whether a

permit had been issued. Staff said that he understood that the site plan must be approved locally before TDOT would issue a permit. Mr. Bolling said he would follow up with TDOT regarding the permit.

Action Taken

On a motion by Mayor Neal and a second by Ms. Wright, on a roll call vote the commission unanimously voted to approve the site plan.

REVIEW OF POSSIBLE ORDINANCE TO DEFINE AND REGULATE ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARDS

The commission reviewed a possible ordinance to define and regulate electronic message boards (EMBs). The ordinance was based on one from Kingsport that was adapted for Kingston. Specifically, the ordinance would allow EMBs in all office, commercial, and industrial districts. The maximum message board portion of the sign would be fifty percent of the maximum allowed ground sign size. The message duration would be twenty seconds with a one second transition. Illumination was limited to 1000 nits between sunset and sunrise and 4000 nits from sunrise to sunset. An automatic dimmer would be required to ensure compliance.

There were a variety of opinions among planning commissioners regarding this issue. Some noted that such signs were here to stay and that the technology allowed for a clean/professional sign. Others noted that such signs don't bring in business and that there was nothing wrong with not allowing such signs. The commission also discussed the brightness of such signs and whether they would adversely affect residential areas. Mr. Bolliing stated that the zoning ordinance currently places restrictions on lighted signs. Lighted signs are not allowed within 300 feet of a residential district unless the sign is not visible from the residential district. Also, Lighted signs are not allowed within fifty feet of a residential district unless it will not direct or reflect light into the residential district.

Action Taken

On a motion by Mayor Neal and a second by Mr. Bacon, the commission voted to recommend the ordinance to the city council. On a roll call vote, all voted yes except for Secretary Pickel who voted no.

UPDATE ON TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Staff reminded commissioners of training to be held from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on August 29 and August 31 at the Jefferson City Fire Hall and the Farragut Town Hall, respectively. The training is regarding Personal Property Rights and will be provided by Mr. Dan Hawk, former director of the Local Planning Office.

<u>ADJOURNMENT</u>

On a motion by Mr. Botkin and a second by Secretary Pickel, the meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
