

The Influent numbers did not change during this test and Sisco did not have any issues with their sewer.

The digester has been painted. The new coat of paint makes the digester look almost brand new.

We completed all the requirements for the DMRQA- 38 study. All areas were within the acceptable levels.

1) Vic King called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

- 2) Joe Parker moved to have the minutes of the September 18, 2018 meeting approved; Carolyn seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.
- 3) Treasurer, Mary Ann Wesolowski was not present at this meeting. New checks will be deposited upon her return. Joe Parker noted that the bank statement is sent to him via an email notification. He forwards it to Emily Steele and she in turn sends it to Mary Ann Wesolowski. Joe will take meaures to have the statement sent directly to Emily Steele and will give her the username and password associated with the account information. Trudy Wideman moved to accept the treasurer's report; Joe Parker seconded and the report was accepted.
- 4) Comments from the public were not available.
- 5) Liz Schreck from the Ocoee Regional Library was present. She discussed topics that were addressed at the 2018 Trustee Workshop held in September. Topics included 'Telling Your Library Story', 'Building Boards with Muscle', and 'Local Government Funding'. Her packet of information included an updated list of the regional library systems throughout the state, a list of Tennessee library acronyms, and a newly revised edition of 'Tennessee Standards for Public Libraries'. She congratulated Mary Ann Wesolowski with a certificate for completing the Tennessee Library Trustee Certification Program and encouraged others to do so.
- 6) Emily Steele presented the Director's Report:
 - a) Children's Programming Four programs were held in September with 55 participants. Extra programs were scheduled during the week of fall break including board games in the morning and tech games in the afternoon.
 - b) Computer Classes Computer classes covering social media had four people in attendance and two people were present for an email class. Emily discussed the possibility of reducing the number classes per month in hopes

- of increasing the number of participants per class. There are three computer classes yet to schedule.
- c) Adult Programs –Five participants enjoyed a craft night and fourteen patrons came to the library for a board game party. Plans are to host board game nights on a monthly basis after the holidays
- d) Circulation Summary Patron count for the month totaled 1,493. There were 1,791checkouts and renewals for adults and 394 for children. READS count for e-books was 2,436.

Joe Parker moved to accept the director's report; Carolyn Brewer seconded and the report was accepted.

7) Old Business:

a) Better World Books – A shipment of books and DVDs withdrawn from the library collection has been sent to Better World Books. Reports are available on line to check for possible sales. Those items that do not sell will be recycled or given away by the company.

8) New Business

- a) Personnel Policy –A workshop with John Eric Grubbs, a representative with The Municipal Technical Advisory Service, aided in the creation of updated personnel policies specific to the Kingston Public Library. A copy of the policies was made available to all board members and Vic King asked that each member look it over before the next meeting in the event there were questions, mistakes, or necessary changes. It will be approved at that time.
- b) Collection Development Policy Emily Steele indicated that the current Collection Development Policy does not require any changes. The Board deferred to her expertise and at this time no changes will be made.
- c) Job Descriptions- Joe Parker suggested that Director Emily Steele review current job descriptions for library staff members and make necessary changes. Emily will bring the revised descriptions to the next board meeting for approval. Liz Schreck will provide Emily with examples of job descriptions for a variety of library positions.

- 10) Chairman's comments Vic King commented on the good meeting and thanked Liz Schreck and the board members for attending.
