

The NPDES permit will expire on December 31, 2018. This year we have a new grant writer, Jack Beach. I have completed all the information and forms requested for the new permit. If we do not have the new permit by then, we are authorized through our current permit.

One of the advantages of completing the permit application allowed me to look closer at the numbers. Our average daily I & I was on average 237,000 gallons per day. Looking at the flow chart, the amount of inflow is related to rainfall.

Jim Tipton and Daniel Bredwell continue to inspect sewer lines with the camera. The camera was not working properly so it was sent off for repairs. We are looking for areas that have open manholes, sump pumps and down spouts connected to the sewer lines. I am also looking for ways to monitor the sewer flows in the lines. I have contacted Wascon to see what options they have available. I will check other places that offer this service.

Labtronix came in to calibrate the lab equipment and the flow monitors at the headworks. There were no issues with any of the equipment.

Tracey Rone from the Cherokee Middle School contacted me about having the gifted students come out and take a tour of the plant in March 2019. More information will be given when details are finalized.
