UTILITY DIRECTOR'S REPORT –Mr. Bolling reported on the recent water issue at Roane Central Utility District causing Roane Medical Center to be out of water. He and Mike Jolly met with Bob Creswell and using the Rockwood Interconnect we are proud we can have the Medical Center water within 10 to 15 minutes. Annual Wastewater Report has been approved by the State. Mr. Bolling also reported the upcoming work the water department employees will be completing - Flushing at dead ends to begin; Pulling Lead and Copper Samples; Testing Backflows and larger meters. There was a water line break which lowered the Bonneyview Tank but is currently being repaired and water should be back to normal by the end of the meeting.

Chairman Neal spoke to the fact of the Rockwood Interconnect could back feed water to the Roane Medical Center.
